- Must be a dependent of an Active Member in Good Standing with the KCEA/MEA/NEA.

- 3. Applicant must demonstrate leadership in school and community activities.
- 4. Two typed letters of recommendation: one from a non-related KCEA member and one from a current or former teacher from the student's district that is not related to applicant.
- 5. Financial need may be considered, but it is not a primary factor in selection.
- 6. A copy of the student's transcript must be included with this application.
- 7. Application deadline: Six (6) copies of application and all accompanying material are due in the KCEA office, 4760 E. Fulton Street, Suite 201, Ada, MI 49301, by 5:00 PM on Friday, April 15, 2022.
